ORDINANCE NO. 2152-13

AN ORDINANCE TO FURTHER AMEND THE AMOUNT OF LODGINGS TAX LEVIED
WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF SYLACAUGA

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Sylacauga, Alabama, that the original lodgings tax levied through Ordinance No. 1580, dated May 6, 1981, amended by Ordinance No. 1712 on September 17, 1986, and further amended by Ordinance 1900 on October 21, 1997, is further amended as follows:

Section I. Purpose of Action Taken:

That *Section II, Subsection (a)* of Ordinance No. 1900, as adopted October 21, 1997, which reads as follows:

*(a) The business of renting or furnishing any room or rooms or lodging to a transient in any hotel, motel, inn, tourist camp, tourist cabin, or any other place in which rooms or lodgings are regularly furnished to transients for a consideration, said tax to be an amount equal to **six percent (6%)** of the gross income received by each person from the renting of rooms or apartments within the corporate limits of the City of Sylacauga.*

Is hereby amended to read:

*(a) The business of renting or furnishing any room or rooms or lodging to a transient in any hotel, motel, inn, tourist camp, tourist cabin, or any other place in which rooms or lodgings are regularly furnished to transients for a consideration, said tax to be an amount equal to **nine percent (9%)** of the gross income received by each person from the renting of rooms or apartments within the corporate limits of the City of Sylacauga.*

Section II. Conflict of Laws and Severability:

Be it further ordained that any ordinance or parts of ordinance of the City of Sylacauga that is found to be in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

That all sections of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable, and if any word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid by the judgment of any court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not affect any of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

That the provisions of this ordinance are cumulative to any other procedures now authorized by law for the accomplishment of the objective hereinbefore stated.

Section III. Date of Effect:


This ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon its adoption and publication as required by law and the increase in the amount of the lodgings tax levy imposed herein shall become effective on December 1, 2013, and shall continue in effect until changed, amended, or repealed by formal action of the City Council.
